A glimmering general far from the battlefield.



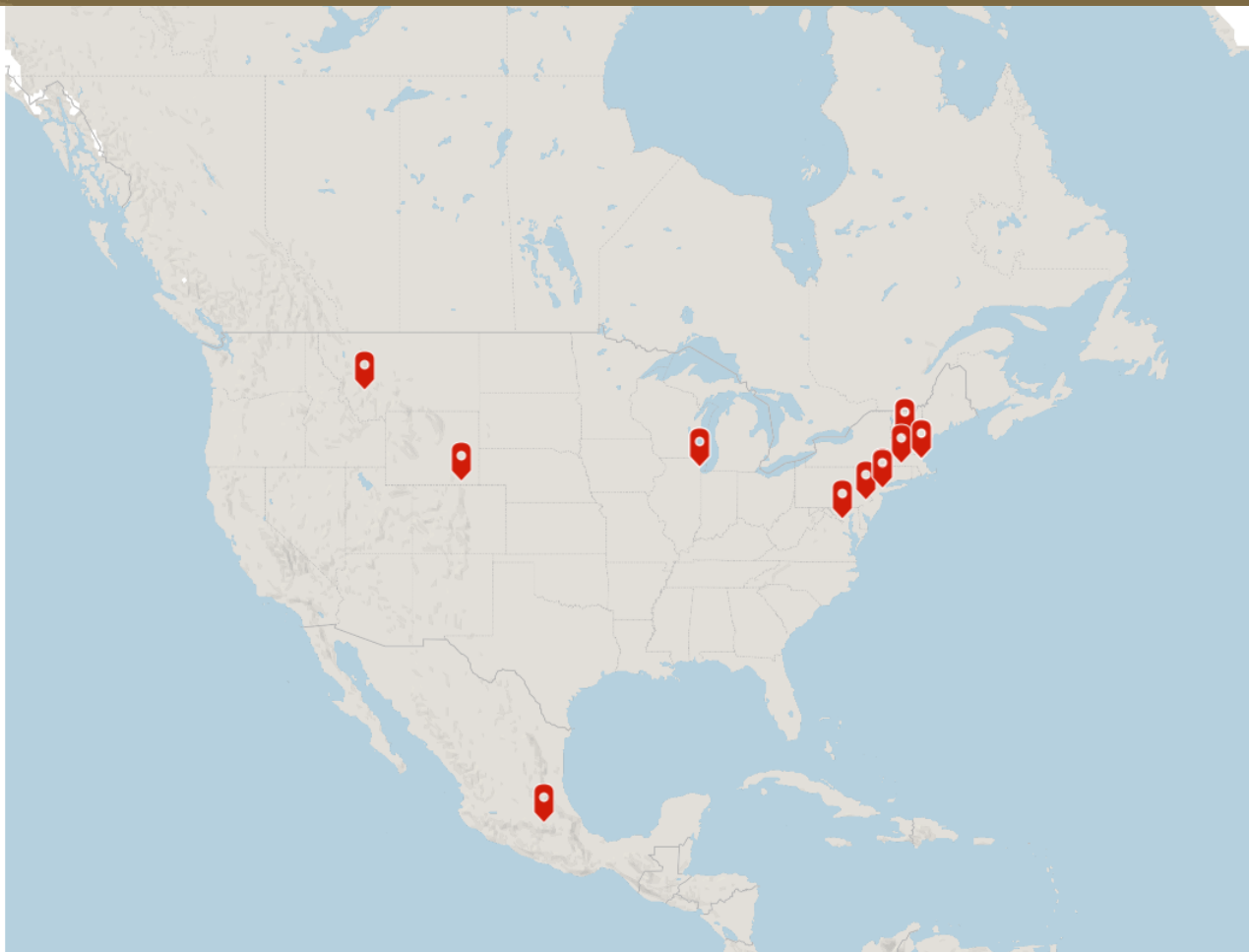

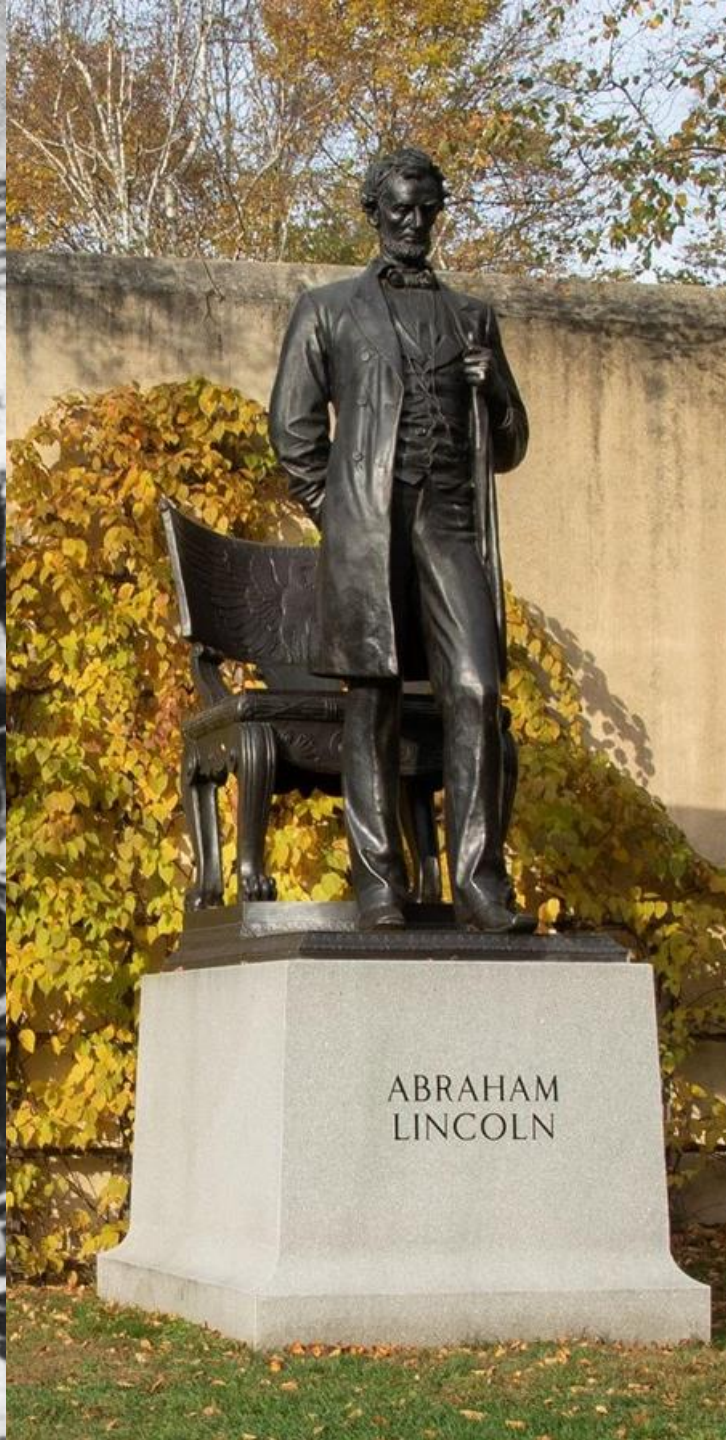
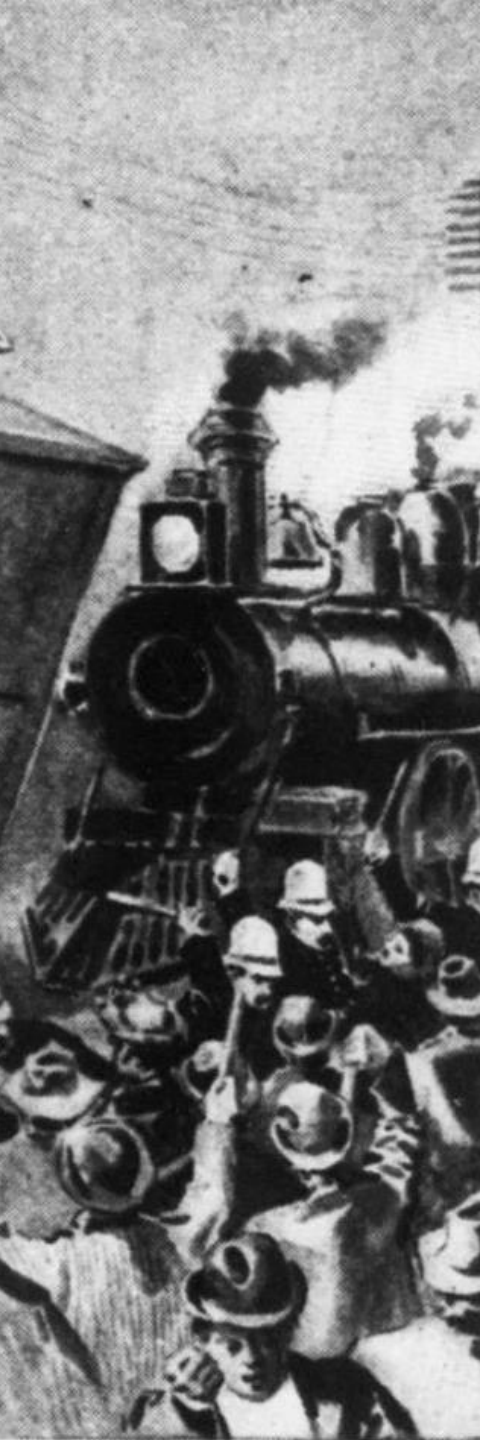
